This matter is before the Court upon the defendant's motion to stay the preliminary injunction hearing scheduled for Tuesday, July 5, 2005 [Record No. 5].

The defendant seeks a stay of the matter until the Second Circuit renders a decision in Suthers, et al. v. Amgen, Inc., No. 05-CV-4158 (PKC) (S.D.N.Y. June 6, 2005), a case against the defendant involving similar issues, but with different plaintiffs. After having considered the matter, the Court finds that because the cases do have different, albeit similar, facts, a hearing on the matter at this time would be beneficial. The Court also finds that the defendant's other stated reason for delaying the hearing, the plaintiffs' alleged delayed filing of the preliminary injunction motion, is not persuasive because the plaintiffs assert that they attempted other remedies before filing a complaint.

Based on the foregoing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the defendant's motion [Record No. 5] be, and the same hereby is, DENIED. The hearing shall take place as previously scheduled.
